



# Primary Hyperbaric Medicine Course

Primary Hyperbaric Medicine Course (PHMC) is a 40-hour introductory course in hyperbaric medicine offered by International ATMO, Inc. International ATMO has conducted hyperbaric medicine training for over 40 years. PHMC is conducted at a location of the customer's choosing. Course dates must be arranged with International ATMO at least 60 days in advance. The fee for this course is \$25,000.00\*. This fee covers all expenses incurred by International ATMO, including the following:

- Tuition for up to 25 registrants
- A PHMC notebook for each registrant, containing all lecture outlines and handout material
- CME credit for physician registrants
- Nursing contact hours for nurse registrants
- All faculty expenses (travel, lodging, transportation, meals, and honorariums)
- All International ATMO administrative expenses (printing, shipping, course documentation, and CME fees)

The customer is responsible for providing the following:

- A meeting room with a screen and seating for the maximum number attending
- Access to a hyperbaric facility for 2 evenings of practicum training during the course
- Transportation of participants to the practicum training (if located away from the meeting room)
- Refreshments for the meeting room during classroom hours

Once International ATMO has committed to a course date, we require a non-refundable deposit of 10% of the course fee (\$2,500.00).

PHMC has received the following approvals:

- This activity is a Designated Introductory Course in Hyperbaric Medicine by the Undersea and Hyperbaric Medical Society (UHMS).
- This activity has been reviewed and approved by the National Board of Diving and Hyperbaric Medical Technology (NBDHMT) as a basic hyperbaric medicine course. This activity meets one of the prerequisites to sit the certification exam for Certified Hyperbaric Technologist or Certified Hyperbaric Registered Nurse.
- This activity has been planned and implemented in accordance with the accreditation requirements and policies of the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (ACCME) through the joint providership of the Undersea & Hyperbaric Medical Society (UHMS) and International ATMO, Inc. Physicians should claim only credit commensurate with the extent of their participation in the activity.
